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## Acting Principal's News

While the Melbourne weather couldn't decide what it was doing from minute to minute this week our Old Orchard students decided they were learning! Walking through the corridors throughout the week I've been so happy to see so many wonderful and varied learning experiences as well as engaged smiling students.

Our Year 2 students are bubbling with excitement in anticipation of the Year 2 sleep over tonight. I am very much hoping the excitement build up will lead to some excellent, prolonged and deep sleep tonight for the sake of the teachers, but I am not sure! This overnight experience is an important part of building independence and personal resilience and preparing our students for a successful overnight camp in Year 3, we hope they all have a great time! Thank you to the incredibly dedicated Year 1 and 2 teachers that will spend their Friday night sleeping on the floor of Drayton Hall!

Congratulations to all of those families that shared in a discussion about being a bystander last week. The power of a strong home and school partnership in tackling behaviours and attitudes can never be underestimated. I'd like to set a different family discussion topic for this week, one that is also currently being addressed regularly by our teachers. We would like to improve the way our students communicate their needs and feelings. As adults we would recognise times in our life where someone may make a comment that we deem to be rude and even at times mean. With the benefit of life experience and the possibility of walking away, we are able to take this in our stride and move on dismissing the comments. This isn't as clear for children, nor do they have the opportunity to 'walk away' from a classmate that they will continue to share daily interactions with for the year. We must encourage each and every student to clearly and immediately state if they don't like a comment being made. The "Please don't do that, I don't like it" that we have always taught our Preps remains a very important message for students to be able to communicate. This is the easiest way for students to understand when a comment they have made is rude and whether or not it hurts the feelings of the person they have said it to and also gives that student a learning opportunity. Obviously if a similar comment is then made again the 'learning' hasn't occurred and a teacher needs to intervene.

We have our 3 way conferences next week. These are a great opportunity to all share in the celebration of progress and discuss some future goals together. Our students have been planning some of the things they would like to tell you about and I'm sure you too will have some messages of praise to add.



Congratulations to our student leader team who have organised the pasta drive to donate pasta to Feed Melbourne. We have collected hundreds of packets of pasta throughout the week. Thanks to the whole school for their generosity and support of this student led initiative.

Yesterday we received the most beautiful thank you card from our friends at Pope Road Kinder (hand delivered by Connor – thank you). Pope Road kindergarten was one our guests to see our performance of Peter Pan. Here is what it said




